Meeting Called to order by Barb Bland. A motion to adopt the agenda was made by Jen Bockenstedt and seconded by Dee Witt (motion approved). A motion to adopt the January 2020 Meeting Minutes was made by Jen Bockenstedt and seconded by Steve Witt (motion approved).

- I. Treasurer's 2020 Report update – Lisa was absent but Barb advised current bank balance is approximately \$31,500
 - A. Outstanding invoices include busing fees from the school (estimated outstanding balance between \$3,000 and \$5,000)
 - B. New uniforms were ordered for Varsity (old uniforms will be passed Varsity to JV, JV to 10th etc.) at a cost of \$4200. With the purchase we get Nike Bucks or a credit that that should pay for socks for the teams.

We also discussed having a volunteer fee/deposit but this was not agreed upon.
